**3. Adoption of the minutes of the parish council meeting held on Monday  
6<sup>th</sup> January 2013.**

The minutes were proposed for adoption by Cllr Hull, seconded by Cllr Johnson and unanimously agreed.

**4. Matters arising from the minutes held on Monday 6<sup>th</sup> January 2013.**

- i) Litter bins A180 and A160 – N.L.C advise that the bins have been emptied weekly but perhaps not always on the same weekly day due to Christmas holidays and the flooding problems. N.L.C advise that the emptying of bins should now revert to one allocated day per week. Clerk to ask N.L.C to undertake a clean – up of the area close to the fish and chip shop on the A160.
- ii) Speed of HGV's Top Road – this road is no longer a Safety Camera Site enforced by the camera vans – it is now in the North Lincolnshire Speed Management Strategy (number 47 of 435 locations) and as it is in the top 48 sites is enforced by the traffic police officers and receives a 3 month period with a flashing speed sign. The flashing speed sign is likely to return between 1<sup>st</sup> January – 31<sup>st</sup> March 2015. Clerk to ask Police Officers to attend with speed guns.
- iii) Hedges – Greengate Lane – Cllr Turner to investigate and offer to trim back hedges for the OAP's if required.

**5. Planning**

Opportunity was given to one person (member of the public) from each side to state, within 3 minutes, objections or support for the application.

- i) Application 2014/0007 – Planning permission to erect a two storey extension – Jacqueline's Cottage, Town Street, South Killingholme.

- ii) To give consideration and to set a budget for the purchase of new table cloths for the small hall – **IT WAS RESOLVED** unanimously to purchase the table cloths to a budget of £70.00.

Cllr Evans reported on the recent KAAG meeting. The new refinery manager was introduced at the meeting – Julian Stoll.
