Cllr Wells mentioned we can apply for money per meter for maintaining footpaths from NTH Lincs Council. Take Lowe heating signs off finance docs. Take supa strikers off. Proposed by Hull seconded Cllr Price. All in favour **Resolved**.
  - III. Income and expenditure for Feb and March. Cllr Oldfield proposed to accept, Cllr Robinson seconded All in favour. **Resolved**
11. **Community Centre**
  - I. Community Payback update. Staff on Annual Leave
  - II. Cleaner contract. Volunteer doesn't have enough time. Advertise for contracted cleaners. Buffer needs maintenance; Cordells to service? Cllr Robinson to get a quote. Clerk to acquire 3 quotes again: hourly quotes this time, whole building and buffing. Once a week 3 hours. Floors especially.
  - III. Bouncy Castle purchase. £600 second hand, withdrawn from agenda.
  - IV. Keys: Keys for small hall didn't work. To take back and replace.

- V. Bar Paint. Cllr Robinson proposed to paint, volunteers to do. Just need tin of paint. Green/grey. Proposed by Cllr Coxon Cllr Oldfield seconded. All in favour. **Resolved**
- VI. Stage paint/varnish. Discussion. Degreaser and Satin Varnish. £60. Proposed to accept by Cllr Robinson and Cllr White seconded. All in favour. **Resolved.**
- VII. EV charge points at CC. On a 6-month waiting list. To check output of energy before contracts signed.
- VIII. Coronation plans. Jenna (Playgroup leader) looking at events with NLC grant.
- IX. Jenny plumber: donated time in emergency for CC. Gratitude shared. Chair informed council she is buying flowers with Chairs allowance.
- X. Chair wanted to Thank Cllr Coxon for fitting new down pipe and sorting new lock on small hall. Thanks to Cllr K. Hesketh and Cllr Price for cleaning and litter picking.

## 12. Parish matters.

- I. Maintenance in village. Footpaths, verges, roads potholes. Discussion Cllr Clark has chased traffic lights up from Jet garage 3 x. Becoming dangerous. Baptist Chapel Lane ruts 1 ft deep, Rd collapsed either side. Virtually single track now. Ward Cllrs state more people need to report it. Ruts on A160 outside Jet garage still not done.
