

Minutes of the Meeting of South Killingholme Parish Council held on Monday July 3rd 2023, commencing at 6.30pm at the Community Centre, Moat Lane, Sth. Killingholme.

1. **Declaration of interest** Cllr Hull and Cllr Evans declared a non-pecuniary interest on item 7 as part of CAG
2. **Parish Council Standing Orders are suspended to allow members of the public and press to make comments and representations for a period of 15 minutes.** Nicola Turnbull: focus on the older children, want to start a £1 social drop in. Refreshments. Leniency on a couple of nights fees whilst it gets established. Proposed once a fortnight, free for 2 months. 1st night small room, if many turn up use large hall. Monday probable day. Proposed by Cllr J. Hesketh, seconded by Cllr Price. All in favour. **Resolved.** 1 DBS in situ, one in progress.

5. **Ward Councillors update:** Cllr Clark; A160 Road reported to Highway England, said it was on repairs list. Cllr Wells correspondence on village signs. Cllrs decided it will be situated near trees on corner of roundabout.

 - I. Bank Reconciliation Proposed to accept by Cllr Robinson, Seconded by Cllr Oldfield. All in favour. **Resolved**
 - II. Income and expenditure for April, May and June, July. Proposed to accept by Cllr Oldfield, seconded by Cllr Robinson. All in favour. **Resolved**
 - III. Audit and Public rights Notice. AGAR and all financial papers agreed. Proposed to accept by Cllr Robinson, seconded by Cllr White. All in favour. **Resolved**
 - IV. Centre Valuation for Insurance in October. No progress, only one quote as yet.
9. **Community Centre**
 - I. Community Payback update. No communication.
 - II. Place planning equality training feedback. Successful survey completed at dog show.
 - III. Clothes bank update. £13.50 to date raised, thanks to community.
 - IV. Skate Park ideas and grant support. Ask NLC for written permission to use field.
 - V. Community Pub suggested by Cllr Cowie, not present but Cllr Robinson suggested two Saturdays a month Cllr Hull proposed to accept idea, Cllr Edwards seconded. All in favour. **Resolved**
 - VI. Combination locks for gates suggested by Cllr White. Cllr Evans suggested we swap key form bowling green to gate. All agreed. **Resolved**
 - VII. Tennis court clearance. No turn out from community payback.
10. **Parish matters.**

- I. Maintenance in village. Footpaths, verges, roads potholes. Path on Habrough Rd roots coming up. NLC confirmed they will see to it. Moat Lane and Briar Close; not done. 2 people in wheelchairs 8-10-12 Greengate lane no access to wheelchairs. Bottom of Green gate drain raised NLC coming out. Top of Greengate resident nearly completed hedges.
- II. Feedback from outside organisations: CAG; none, NATs meeting; lorries in Ulceby reduced, just lorries to farms now, ASB SK high at the moment, Camera back on Lancaster R. Musmer fly tipping; no progress but member of public reported chemicals and lithium batteries sat in water decaying to environmental agency, not dealt with. Cllr Clark will follow up, NLAG: not attended.
- III. In Bloom update and thanks to volunteers for doing planters, every planter except Mayflower. Thanks to Cllr Coxon for caretaking plugs and donations of plants. Vandalism with one near bridge, caught on camera.
- IV. Community Bus Trip. Cllr Cowie quotes and locations to be arranged.
- V. Baptist Chapel up for sale again. Discussion.
- VI. Villagers concerned about 30mph limit. Cllr Edwards asked if we could pay and put-up signs to encourage slower traffic speeds. NLC charge £3-£4000 for signs. Clerk to e mail Ian Jickells or Gareth Denovan and enquire.
