A parishioner stated that they would like to see a more proactive approach from the Parish Council. Lots of funding exists and it would be nice to see the council applying for this. There is a lack of facilities for the 8+ range. Forward thinking Councils use words such as 'projects', 'strategies' and 'goals' which he hasn't heard at South Killingholme.

The Parishioner asked for clarity on the Council's Assets and the Clerk agreed to forward a copy.

Moat Meadow was raised as a potential development – A councillor confirmed that more trees were to go in and there had been a new set of gates to replace the rusted ones. Seeds and trees had been purchased through grants. The parishioner suggested applying to NLC for community orchards and to explore the option of a bike park or skate park at the cost of 40-125k at the Meadow.
